Ignacio Asensio joins the firm as Managing Director of the New Investments Division and Member of the Executive Committee, initially be based in London. Ignacio was the former Head of Origination and Execution in the EMEA region, for Cubico Sustainable Investments. He was part of the team that span-off Cubico from Banco Santander and brings a breadth of hands-on experience, having been responsible for the origination, acquisition and management of Cubico's key investments, including the acquisition of T-Solar from I-Squared in 2021. He also held prior positions at Santander Capital Structuring and Societé Générale Leverage Finance divisions in Spain, Hong Kong and Australia. Ignacio holds a Master's degree in Industrial Engineering from Universidad Politécnica de Madrid (Spain).
